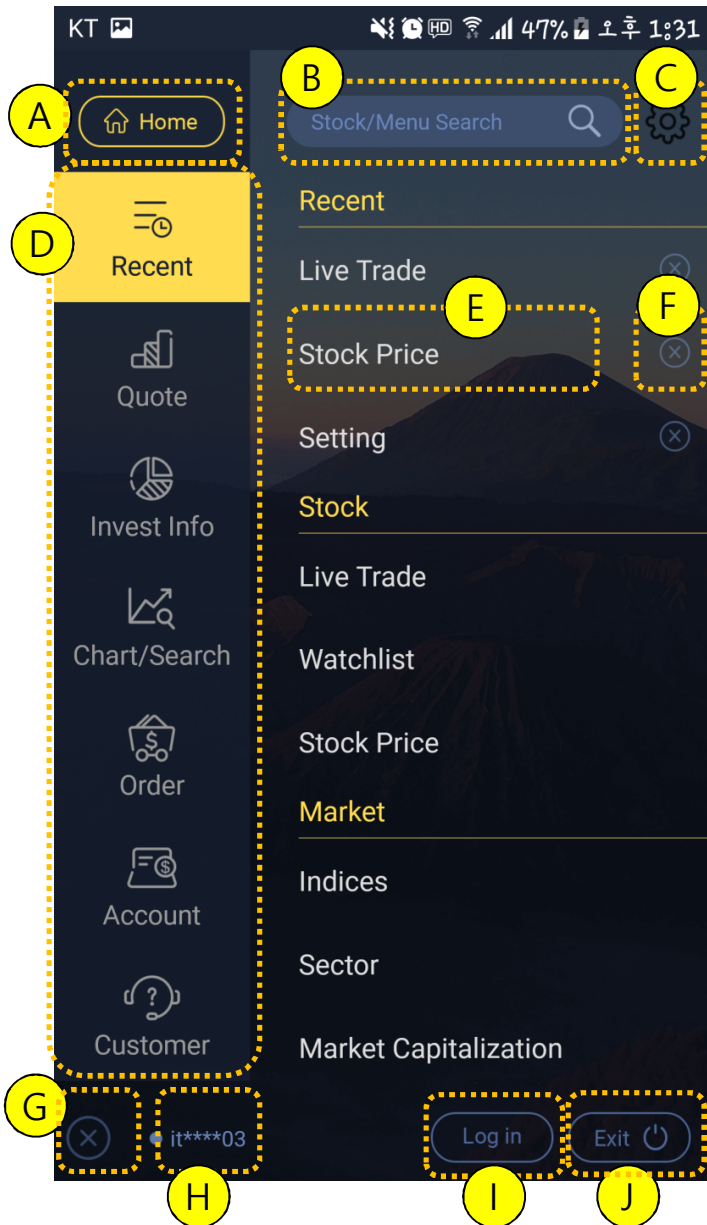

1. Automatic Order Screen Overview

: It is a screen that implements function to set/check/modify monitoring condition, order quantity, and order price so that the order can be processed according to the specified quantity and price set by user. It includes function to check the processed order details according to the applied conditions.

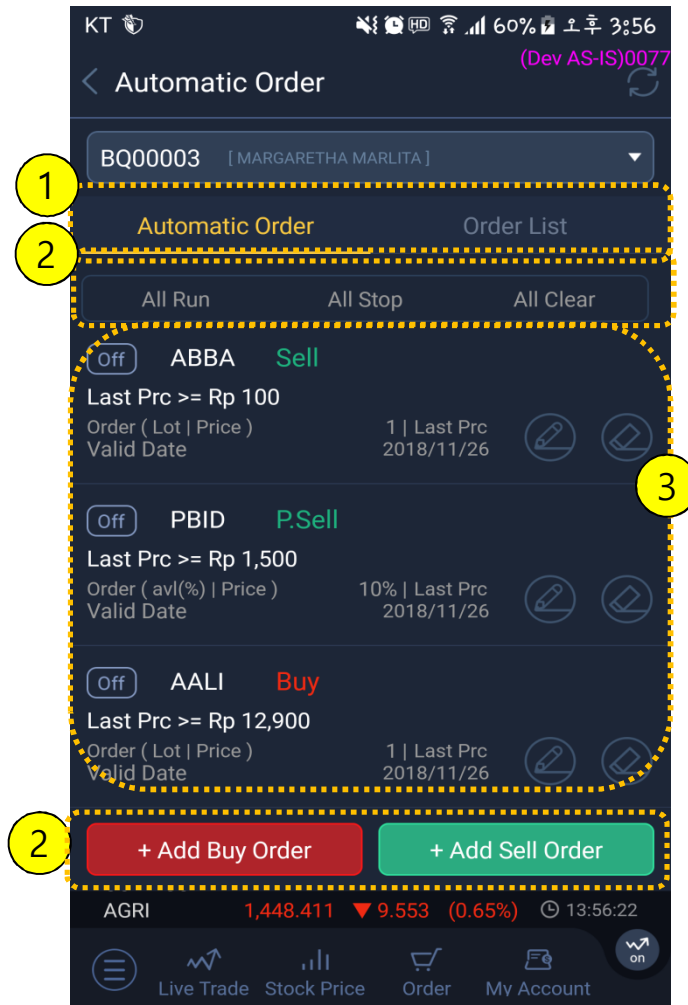
2. Automatic Order Screen Configuration

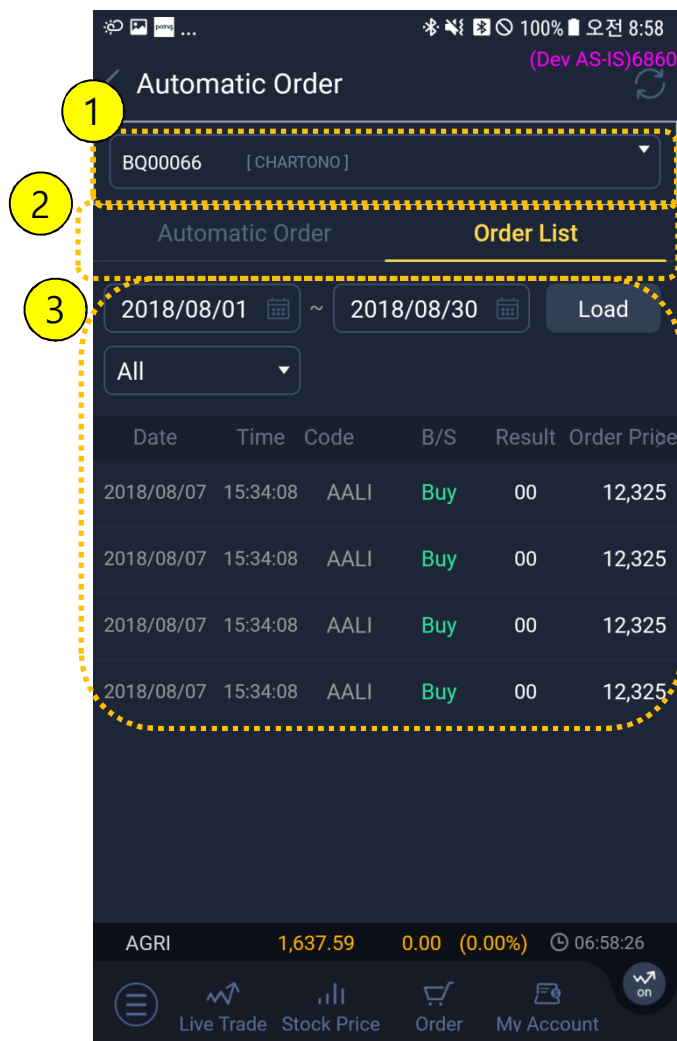

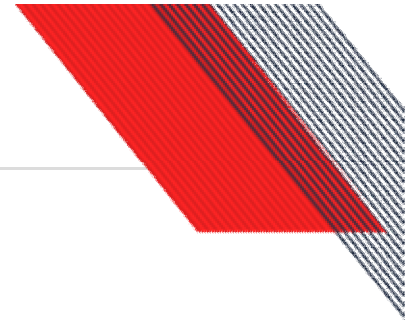
When you start monitoring after saving your setting, if the closing price, through server logic, reached the condition set in Setting Condition, the order will be processed with the price and quantity you've set in Volume and Order Price.

3.5. P.Sell Order Setting

- : Select and set stock balance, then at the same time, the order will be set based on balance quantity.
- : After finished setting, changes of the stock balance will not be reflected to Automatic Order.
