Market Commentary

- JCI extended Monday's gain as strong rebound in tech shares lifted the benchmark to close right above 6800 levels.
- Upbeat global sentiments also added to the risk-on mood as European equity futures and Asian stocks advanced ahead of US CPI data.
- Tech shares were on a roll, as GOTO IJ woke up from its slumber as the share price of e-commerce giant traded in the green after traded at limit for eleventh straight sessions. ARTO IJ +24.84%, BUKA IJ +6.87%.
- Large-cap shares tied to GOTO IJ climbed with TLKM IJ and ASII IJ both rose more than 1%, while major banks traded mixed. ASII IJ +2.64%, TLKM IJ +1.35%.
- Coal miners pulled after yesterday gain, as investors gyrated into tech sector. PTBA IJ -2.10%, ADRO IJ -1.57%.
