#### **Market Commentary**

- JCI ended 89pts lower, losing 304 pts or falling 4.34% throughout the week. The index opened with weakness with the selling pressure intensified in the late session, regional markets rose as inflation data take center stage.
- Trading activity were dominated by large-cap stocks, although trading value were relatively thin with GOTO IJ and TLKM IJ weighed the most.
- All sectors traded in the red, led by energy and tech.
- Large cap banks remained under pressure as global fund outflow hits nearly three-month high as investors shifted focus to China and HK market amid reopening plan. BBRI IJ -0.82%, BMRI IJ -1.24%.
- Coal miners tumbled amid a pullback in coal prices as China's coal market faced unusually bleak winter for demand. UNTR IJ -4.30%, ADRO IJ 1.60%.
- Top Gainers: BBCA (+0.88%), TBIG (+4.33%), BEBS (+2.22%)
- Top Losers: BYAN (-6.87%), GOTO (-7.00%), TLKM (-2.41%)

#### Macroeconomic, Sector and Corporate News

- BALI IJ plans to issue IDR 221bn sukuk w/ 370 days & 3 years tenor. Offering period: 13Dec2022. (Investor daily)
- INDY IJ subsidiary Indika Energy Capital III and Indika Energy Capital IV bought back USD 41.44mn of their outstanding bonds maturing in 2024 & 2025. (Investor daily)
- KIJA IJ to issue USD265.5mn bonds to partially refinance its USD300mn bonds maturing in 2023. (Investor daily)
- TSPC IJ to distribute IDR25/sh interim dividend (~1.8% yield). Cum date: 16Dec2022. (Bisnis)
- UNTR IJ allocates USD220mn capex for nickel smelter construction (estimated to be within 3 years) after acquiring the Stargate nickel mine and smelter. (Bisnis)
- BMAS IJ Kasikorn Vision Financial (KVF) has officially become the controlling shareholder of BMAS w/ 67.5% stakes. (Bisnis)
